#### Abstract

This study aims to explain the process and the outcomes of the discipline and religious activity to improve the moral value of adolescent in SMA PGRI VI Malang in 2017. This study applies an action research using Kemmis and McTaggart which consists of four stages: (1) planning, (2) action, (3) observation and (4) reflection. Data were analyzed by using quantitative and qualitative data analysis. Quantitative data were obtained from the test scores of teenage in improving their moral value through instruments that have been made. Meanwhile, the qualitative data were analyzed by using the techniques proposed by Miles and Huberman which consists of data reduction, data display, and conclusion. The results of this study show that the discipline and religious activity can increase the teenage moral value that is the average pre-intervention results by 53.42% and the results of the second cycle of82.28%, there is an increase of 28.86%. Therefore, it can be concluded that discipline and religious activity one of the ways to improve teenage moral value.
